

Activists from India, Pakistan to attend peace meet

New Delhi, Jan 7 (PTI) With the Indo-Pak dialogue process showing no signs of revival, politicians and activists from both sides including former Prime Minister I K Gujral will assemble for a three day meet here to chart out a roadmap for peace.

The India-Pakistan Conference, to be held from January 10 to 12, will not only see peace activists and political leaders coming together, but will also give space to representatives from Kashmir and Balochistan.

"The idea is to get experts and activists who have spent their lives promoting peace on the same platform... to map out a charter for peace to exert pressure on both governments," veteran journalist Kuldip Nayar told reporters here today.

The three day conference will include discussions on crucial subjects like militancy, trade as an instrument of peace and climate change and its impact on Indo-Pak relations.
